No Sew Fleece Blanket Instructions

Make a blanket for a child in crisis!

My Stuff Bags are duffels of new belongings for children entering crisis shelters with nothing of their own. A handmade blanket is the “soul” of every My Stuff Bag!

You will need:

1 ½ yards of fleece fabric (single ply)

Scissors

Ruler

Marker or crayon



1. Trim any rough selvage off the sides of the blanket fabric.
2. Cut 4x4 squares from each corner of the blanket. Use your ruler to measure and lightly outline the square with a marker or crayon. (Save the cutouts and send or bring them back to the Foundation with your finished blanket/s, we use them!)
3. Cut 1”x4” strips around the entire blanket to create fringe. You can measure each strip with two fingers.
4. Tie single knots in the middle of each strip. **Finished blankets should be no larger than 50x70 inches. Blankets must be single ply!!!**
